

Wordbee makes major gains in Japanese translation market

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<u>Wordbee</u> continues to make major gains in the Japanese translation market with the recent announcement that <u>Nikon Precision</u> Inc. has signed up to its Translation and Project Management SaaS (Software as a Service) system.

The gains made in the Japanese market reflect Wordbee's move beyond the novelty of being a first generation web-based translation management system. Nikon Precision executive Mr. Andrew Jones explains, "Wordbee dominates Japanese language support and modern workflows, helping us to keep our costs down."

And we found that it handles all three major Japanese syllabaries, and Wordbee provides the interface in Japanese as well."

According to Wordbee, the full list of Japanese features includes a Japanese interface, support for Kanji, Hiragana and Katakana syllabaries, Japanese date formats, Japanese-specific calendars, as well as full-width and half-width numbers. This technology is used in other areas of the translation management system to provide accurate word counts, and correct segmentation, as well as translation memory applications including pre-translation.

Nikon Precision executive Mr. Andrew Jones summed it up, saying "After considering different web-based translation tools, we decided to go with Wordbee due to their extensive Japanese language support features."
