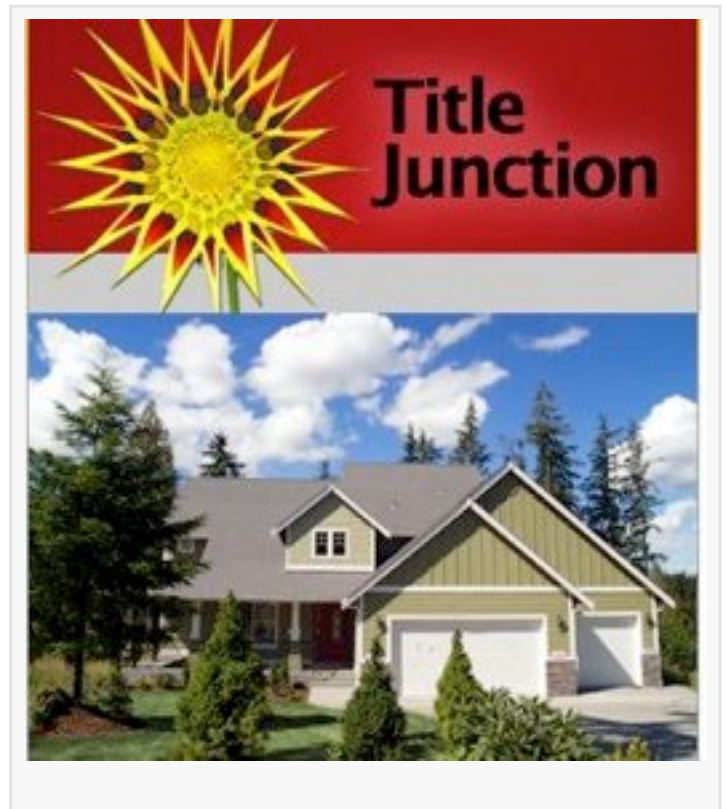


Fort Myers Title Insurance Company Plans Educational Retreat For Employees
