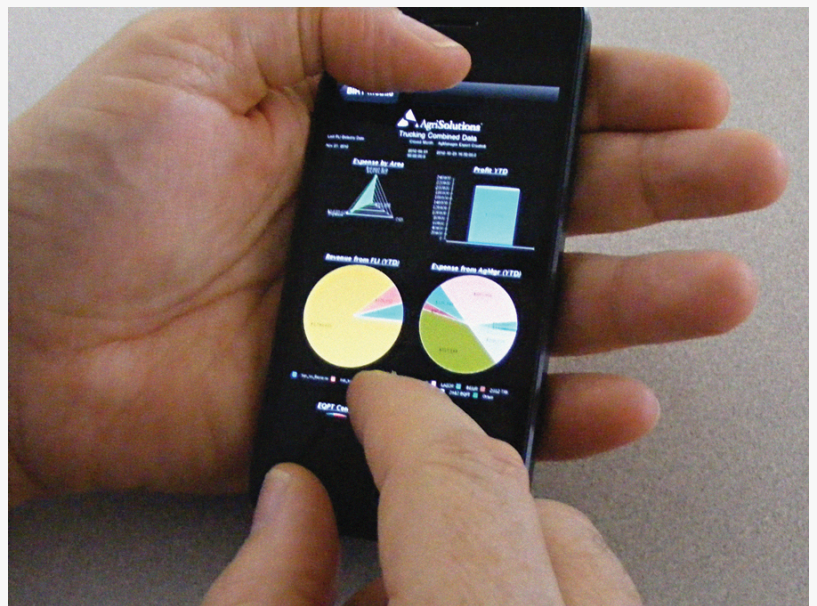
Until now, AgriSolutions has made its newest proprietary technology and software offerings available only to its current clients.
