piece must be performed in an intimate space because it's an all-or-nothing work. I'm on edge the whole time and it's very private and intense. I need the energy from the audience."

Exploring identity, loss of childhood and the female body as temple, weapon and fertile ground, Blood/Nectar/Glitter has not a wasted moment, speaking the artist's truth without reservation. Blood/Nectar/Glitter opens with the traumatic onset of menstruation, the harrowing divide between girl and woman and pushes through a private crisis and ultimate metamorphosis-dramatic, stark, provocative, deeply emotional and fearless, it is a <u>dance-theatre</u> work not for the faint of heart and is a perfect fit for Manhattan Repertory Theatre's daring February Event.

Founded by Ken Wolf and Jennifer Pierro in 2005, Manhattan Rep has produced over 900 plays and more than 10,000 theatre artists have participated. Manhattan Rep is committed to the

artist, to creating a context of creativity and support in a clean and professional environment. Manhattan Rep celebrates unbridled creativity, not judgement, and believes that a script is not a play, just the map for a creative team to bring it to life. Alongside Suzana Stankovic's work, The February Event will include, 'Your Worst Critic' by Andrew Houlihan; 'Three Sides of the Knife' by Helene Montagna; 'A Mean Eye' by Louise Graham and 'I (HEART) U' by Angel Dillemuth.
