

## Victor Martin Launches 'Two and Half Million' to Achieve Emancipation

/EINPresswire.com/ Martin a guy of 27 year old is selling pixels on a website to get raise over 1 million euros to finance his emancipation.

New site <u>www.twoandhalfmillion.com</u> is a bulletin board of 2.5 million pixels at the price of 0.50 € the unit.

The pixels are sold in blocks of 200 being able to make larger groupings to insert logos featured.

Martin says the site is "completely legitimate and real."

"I think in most cases it will be of interest to businesses and large companies may be buying lots of pixels to have a more prominent position on the site," he says.

Given the current <u>economic crisis</u> existing in Spain does not offer opportunities to find steady work, so he talked about a method to make him earn enough money to seek opportunities abroad.

He get enough money after emancipation plans to reinvest the money in another business.

So far it has sold more than 2,000 pixels, including several companies in the same industry in his hometown.

The website is written in both English and <u>Spanish</u>, increasing accessibility to users, in addition to double bonds exist for each advertiser.

"I guarantee that I keep it online for at least four years, but I want to do for as long as humanly possible," says he wants to turn it into a permanent wall.

The idea is to sell pixels for advertisers to insert a logo with a link to a website to advertise in the space purchased.

The site will be online for at least four years that are guaranteed but the idea is that they are becoming a lot more permanent poster that will enter the history of the internet.
