

Presentation.io launches synced presentation for all devices. MIT, Yale already on board.

Presentation.io lets you stay in sync with your audience. As the presenter, you can sync your presentations to the mobile devices, tablets and laptops of your audience - no matter whether you are in the same room or in different parts of the world. You just hand out the direct link and everyone connected will be able to follow the slides live on his or her own device and interact with real-time comments and chat during or after the presentation.

Over 20 different file types are supported and it will work in any browser, just hand out the link and the audience is connected; no need to download an app, or log into any system.

Presentation.io is a product by the team behind real-time visual collaboration platform, CanvasDropr.com. CanvasDropr contained a synced presentation feature but more and more CanvasDropr customers requested this product as a separate service.

"Presentation.io is a reaction to pure customer demand. It is also the first step in moving towards a leading role in synchronous collaboration and communication solutions online, says co-founder Cathrine Andersen.

The two Danes, Cathrine Andersen and Christian Rasmussen founded CanvasDropr in 2011. The platform for visual collaboration for creatives has users in over 140 countries around the world, is used at e.g. teams at Sony, HTC and Nike and was named one of the best apps of 2013 by PCMag last week. With CanvasDropr growing customer demand for CanvasDropr in especially creative and health industries, the company has been able to free up resources to take the first step in the direction towards a leading role within synced collaboration and communication online.

The free version of Presentation.io can be used by anyone. Presentations will be stored under the unique URL for 48 hours and notes, comments, etc. will be available to the presenter and the audience for that time. If presenters want to save presentations for later so they and the audience can access them again and e.g. view notes and comments made to the slides during the presentation, presenters can upgrade to a premium account for \$14 per month.
