FringeFX was recently acquired by Nelly De Mol, a web developer and community leader with the mission of providing a friendly and professional artist community to artists and also photographers.

While Nelly is not an artist herself, she has a track of records dating back to 1996. Nelly De Mol has managed and developed communities which host just a hand-full of members up to communities with millions of users.
