

CCVS 2013 to continue its success in Wuhan

China's first and largest nationwide commercial vehicles show

WUHAN, CHINA, July 12, 2013 /EINPresswire.com/ -- After its debut in 2012, China Commercial Vehicles Show 2013 (CCVS) will be held on 30 October-2 November at the Wuhan International Expo Center. This year, the number of exhibitors and exhibits will be further enlarged, which cover mainstream global producers of trucks, special purpose vehicles and related automotive parts, various vehicles including heavy truck, middle truck, light truck, pick-up truck, light bus, special purpose vehicle and specialty car as well as accessories and spare parts.

The concurrent activities during the show include a wide range of high-standard industrial forums and conferences to help all participants gain maximum benefits through CCVS. China International Commercial Vehicles Summit 2013, The Forum on the Development of China Special Purpose Vehicle Industry, test driving of trucks and driving skill demonstration, to name just a few, are all highlighted activities under planning.
