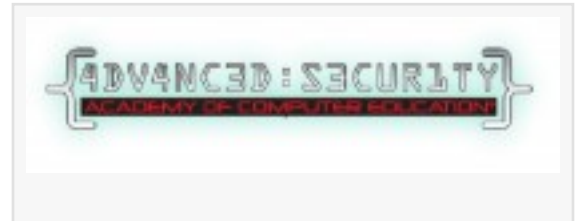


TrainACE Releases Free Certified Ethical Hacker Exam Study Guide
