It'd be an honor to be invited to play again at Desert Uprising with another great line-up that includes some of our biggest musical inspirations," says Killing Spree guitarist, Marc Price.

About the Band: Killing Spree is a heavy rock/metal band hailing from Phoenix, Arizona, featuring Jeffrey Robens (Vocals/Programming), Marc Price (Guitar), David Gilles (Guitar), Jason Laidlaw (Bass, Vocals), and Dustin Vaughan (Drums). With music often described as an episode of Dexter personified, Killing Spree isn't afraid to push the limits of gore and suspense with a sense of bittersweet finality.
