Bovada Poker's Zone Poker software incorporates a formula that determines which player has not paid the big blind yet, whether it is a first-hand player or a player who has played numerous hands but has not yet been in the big blind position. Furthermore, if a player has not paid the big blind in the longest amount of time than anyone else at the table, then that player will automatically be seated in the big blind position. If numerous players qualify for the big blind role, one of them will be selected randomly to take the seat. Therefore, a player may pay more or less big blinds in the long run, than in a regular online poker session.

Players are given the same amount of time to act as they would have in a normal game; however, there is no waiting time between hands and no waiting for other players to carry out the hand after folding.

Everything else is the same as far as rules of the game go. Even graphics and animation are not sacrificed in Zone Poker. Fast-paced is the new trend in online poker, and Bovada Poker has the first US-friendly version in Zone Poker.
