Cadillac CTS Technology

The other engine options include a 6-speed transmission that has been equipped with paddle shifters and a 3.6 liter V-6 engine. This option is exclusively offered for the new, twin-turbocharged engine. Each engine provides the speed and power that is expected from a vehicle under the Cadillac name.

Cadillac CTS Safety Procedures

In addition to the many interior, exterior and engine features and options, Cadillac has also increased the standard safety features on every 2014 Cadillac CTS. This includes 10 air bags, as well as OnStar telematics that includes one year of free services for Automatic Collision Notification. The sensors for rear park-assist are included standard in each vehicle, reducing the chances of accidents in parking lots.

Cadillac can install some optional safety features including a reversing camera with a real cross-traffic alert system. Some other new safety options that are offered include adaptive headlights that aid when driving around dark curves, Panic Brake Assist, lane-departure warning, side blind-zone alert, forward-collision warning and a rear and from braking system. Many of these new technologies are also equipped to provide a vibration in the driver's seat to warn the driver, without alarming them.
