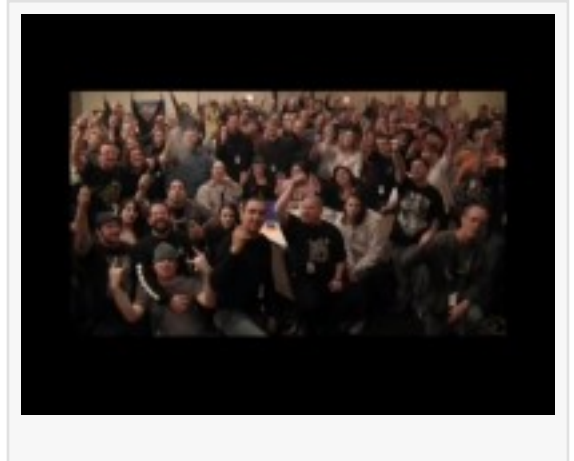


Hundreds of E-cigarette Users Convene in Las Vegas

With the e-cigarette industry booming, more than 50 e-cigarette vendors from across the world will be represented and provide free product samples and sell product. Due to the need for education in the rapidly growing industry, free workshops will be offered on all aspects of e-cigarette use from legal and science to how to workshops. and many free giveaways.
