Included with that technology is an all-new active valve exhaust system, which allows the vehicle to achieve a wider rpm range and a 13-percent improvement in highway fuel efficiency over the previous SRT8 generation. Meanwhile, the 6.4L HEMI® V8 engine provides 470 horsepower and 465 pound-feet of torque which is 45 more Hp and 50 pound-feet more torque than previous models.

"The Grand Cherokee SRT8 is the most powerful Grand Cherokee ever without a doubt, but it has more than power on its side. There is a level of control available to drivers that we've never seen before. For example, the new transmission has 99 different shift maps available, which is unprecedented in mass-produced autos.
