- Sensitivity to Hot or Cold Temperatures
- Pain When Biting or Chewing
- Pimple Eruption on Gums
- Swelling and Tenderness in Gums
- Discoloring of the Tooth

Dr. Brain Pressley, who heads the practice, says, "There are many reasons that you may need a root canal, including a cracked tooth, an exposed nerve ending, or a deep cavity. A root canal is typically performed to save an infected or decaying tooth. If your tooth is left untreated and your infection continues to grow, an abscess can form and cause bone loss in your jaw."

Root canals from Premier Smiles of Charlotte are performed instead of tooth extractions. The dentist makes sure the entire oral area is cleaned before instilling fillers inside of the affected tooth. After the filler is in the correct place, a sealant is applied to the tooth to guard against any possibility of infection in the future.
