The gUnify Connector for Gmail solution also includes the gUnify Click-to-Dial browser extension. The extension allows users to click-to-dial any number appearing in a Google Chrome browser and connects the call through their BroadSoft service provider.

The gUnify Connector for Salesforce.com also includes the Click-To-Dial browser extension, and automatically logs all incoming and outgoing call data, captures user's call notes, and records this information in Salesforce.com. The gUnify Connector for Salesforce.com is enabled via the Google Chrome browser extension.
