NuVet Labs has also chosen to support Santa Paula Animal Rescue Center, a community-based no-kill animal shelter in Santa Paula, CA. Created in 2011, S.P.A.R.C. is a shelter where homeless animals are brought for humane care without the risk of being killed due to lack of space, illness or injury. S.P.A.R.C. focuses on re-homing and rehabilitating animals while at the same time
