Trying to make people aware of problems relating to perception of leakage management (use of inappropriate and misleading performance indicators (paper).

Disseminating latest international advances in understanding and predicting the many benefits of smart pressure management in distribution systems, including reduction in burst frequency and extension of residual infrastructure life.

Q - Tell us about the conference and your participation
