The necklace features a forged black iron diamond-shaped pendant adorned with a steel scroll filigree design that frames an eye-catching crimson red and black center. The color is not a stone but rather a metallic modelling resin that Laura hand-molds into the bezel. The pendant hangs from a stainless steel chain.

"I was inspired to create a piece of jewelry that looked like it could have been designed and made centuries ago but that would fit in easily with the contemporary setting of the show," Laura notes. "I love how well it paired with Bonnie's unique style."

Laura is not a newcomer to The Vampire Diaries. Her Celtic Cross Necklace was worn by actor Charles Bewley (Galen Vaughan) on multiple episodes of Season 4 and another piece will be worn by character Maria on Episode 5:21.
