

## Pro-Kremlin RIA Novosti Stops Updating English Language Service

Key Russian Propaganda News Tool Not Being Updated

WASHINGTON, DC, UNITED STATES, May 2, 2014 /EINPresswire.com/ -- The crisis in Ukraine and Russia's role in it have been top world news for several weeks now. So why would Vladimir Putin – whose government controls the pro-Kremlin news agency RIA Novosti – give up the opportunity to shape global opinion via one of Moscow's main propaganda tools?

Its pro-Kremlin reputation notwithstanding, RIA Novosti is read and cited by some journalists and its articles are available e.g. through Google News,
