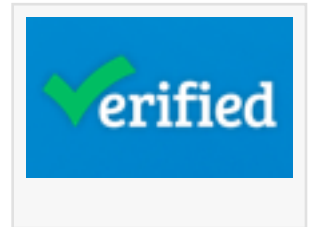


Verified Learning Enters into Partnership with the World Council of Optometry
