Balance disorders can occur at any age, but are of special concern in elderly patients since they can lead to falls and injuries. The inner ear plays a crucial role in a person's ability to retain their balance and is the cause of many balance problems. The vestibular organs in the ear are connected to a large network of nerves and brain cells. Any interruption in the flow of communication in that network can lead to dizziness, vertigo or problems retaining equilibrium.

"There are many, many things that can affect balance so we always start our examination with a thorough medical history and assessment of vital signs. This helps us eliminate physical problems like blood pressure or even something as simple as a build-up of fluid in the ear from a recent cold or allergies. If the preliminary exam doesn't turn up anything, we move on to diagnostic and physical tests to identify the cause," said Jaffe.

There are a variety of specialized therapy programs for confirmed balance disorders that can be used to treat patients. Each plan treats a particular balance issue to successfully restore balance

and mobility and allow the patient to return to their normal activities.

Jaffe Sports Medicine is staffed with specialists in sports medicine and physical therapy in Naples. Patients do not need referrals to receive treatment at the facility, since their boardcertified doctors are able to diagnose injuries, set up comprehensive treatment plans and follow the patients' progress with the therapists.
