

## Refresh & Rejuvenate for Summer!

NEW YORK, NEW YORK, USA, June 23, 2014 /EINPresswire.com/ -- Summer is here and everyone wants to look their best and see immediate results, the best way to do that without surgery is by using dermal fillers. As we age, we start to lose volume, the face is the first place to generally show signs of that. Dermal fillers are injectable gels or substances used to add volume to deflated facial areas and improve fine and deeper lines. Most types are comprised of hyaluronic acid, a substance found naturally in the body. Some areas improved with fillers include lips, sunken cheeks, temple hollows, "parenthesis lines" (nasolabial folds the junction between the cheek and lip area) and "marionette lines" (lines that run straight down from the corners of the mouth).

<u>Juvederm</u> Voluma XC, is the newest facial filler to become available (Hyaluronic acid-naturally occurring substance found in a multitude of cells throughout the body). It's a soft injectable gel placed in the deep layers of the cheek to correct age-related volume loss in adults over the age of 21. The injection also contains a numbing agent called Lidocaine, to reduce pain during the procedure and a topical numbing agent may also be applied prior to the procedure to further reduce any discomfort. A more youthful appearance may be obtained during the procedure which can last up to 2 years, quite often patients desire two syringes.

Radiesse is a volumizing filler (Calcium Hydroxyapatite-a naturally occurring mineral found in the body) used to correct moderate to severe facial wrinkles and folds of the cheeks and nasolabial folds. It can also be used around the mouth (excluding lips), chin and even bridge of the nose. Lidocaine is added to the Radiesse to reduce injection discomfort. The results last up to one year, the larger syringe is usually enough for a full treatment.

Perlane-L is a Hyaluronic acid mixed with Lidocaine. Similar to both Voluma and Radiesse, Perlane is used to correct moderate to severe facial wrinkles especially around the nasolabial folds. It is projected to last between 6-12 months. It is slightly less expensive than Radiesse.
