

NANOG 62 CALL FOR PRESENTATIONS NOW OPEN

Event To Take Place October 6-8, 2014 in Baltimore, MD

NANOG 61 in Bellevue, WA was NANOG's largest and best-attended event to date with nearly 900 attendees throughout the three-day meeting. The NANOG Program Committee is now seeking proposals for presentations, panels, tutorials, track sessions and keynote materials for the NANOG 62 program. Candidates are encouraged to submit presentations describing complex problems and interesting solutions relating to deployed or soon-to-be deployed Internet technology as well as real-world deployment experiences. Submissions in all areas of network operations will be considered, including (but not limited to) topics regarding:

- Power and Facilities Power reliability and engineering, green power, power efficiency, cooling, and facilities management;
- Interconnections Internet Exchanges (IXs), intra-building, MMR, metro-wide connections, peering, and transit purchasing tactics and strategies;
- Security Routing security, route filtering of large peers/ customers, and inter-AS security and cooperation;
- Domain Name System (DNS) DNS data for network metrics, botnet discovery, and geolocation;
- IPv6 Real-world deployment challenges, Carrier-Grade NAT, NAT-PT implementations that work and scale, and allocation strategies:
- Content Distribution (p2p, IPTV), content payment models, content distribution technologies and networks, and storage/archiving; and
- Disaster Recovery Risk analysis, training, agencies, planning methods, hardware portability, key tools, transport audits, and other lessons learned.

Presentation abstracts and draft slides are due by August 4, 2014. To submit a presentation for consideration at NANOG 62, use the tool located on the Program Committee Site. Lightning talk proposals may be submitted on the Program Committee Site starting October 5, 2014.

The NANOG 62 topic list will be posted August 18, 2014. Selected participants may turn in their final presentation slides no later than September 1, 2014. The final NANOG 62 agenda will be published September 15, 2014.
