

# A1 Limousine Announces Discounts for 4th July Celebrations

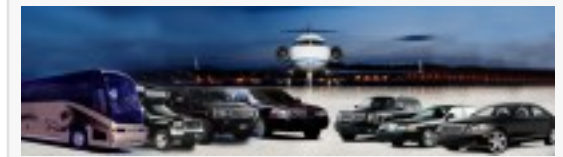
