The Highlands and The Brute at Grand Geneva Resort & Spa
Golfers can choose from two tournament-quality 18-hole courses at the Grand Geneva Resort & Spa. The Highlands offers a cultural experience, similar to the scenic hills of Northern Scotland. This par-71 course takes full advantage of the lush, natural landscape of the Wisconsin countryside. The Brute, at over 7,300 yards, is one of the most challenging layouts in the Midwest. This par-72 course has huge rolling greens and 68 bunkers.

Lake Lawn Resort's Championship Course

Located among 275 tree-lined acres, Lake Lawn Resort's championship golf course in Delavan is a historic masterpiece, first opened in 1921 and then spectacularly re-engineered in 1990 by renowned architect Dick Nugent, known for his work at Kemper Lakes. This course is best known for its stately oaks, deep sand bunkers and subtle undulations.

Como Crossings and Barn Hallow at Hawk's View Golf Club

Serious golfers choose championship caliber Como Crossings for its spectacular views and a 7,074-yard, par-72 challenging layout. Como Creek winds throughout the course, complementing the scenic woodlands and rolling topography. Beginners, families and kids enjoy a walkable par-3 experience on the Barn Hallow course.
