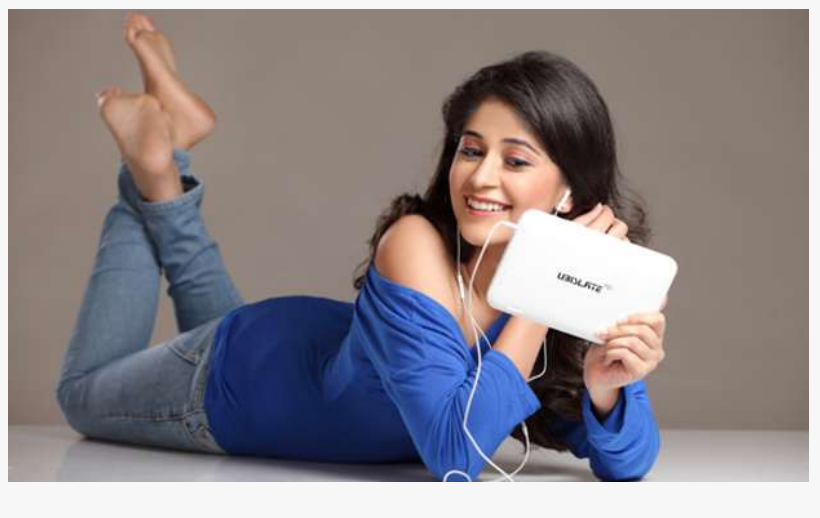


The Way of Tablets Price in India
