Criminal defense lawyer Russell Matson will speak at the Boston Freedom Rally, in support of marijuana law reform and legalization.

Polling shows that more than half of voters in Massachusetts and nationwide support legalization of marijuana. Marijuana use was legalized in Colorado and Washington state by ballot initiatives in 2012, with retail sales operations starting this year. Activists are working to have a similar legalization initiative on the ballot in Massachusetts in 2016.
