The team performs major surgery covered by Ontario Health Insurance Plan at the hospital. Other procedures covered by OHIP and all cosmetic surgeries are done at the clinic's surgical center, a certified independent health facility that is fully accredited by the Canadian Association for Accreditation of Ambulatory Surgical Facilities (CAAASF).

In addition to specializing in breast reconstruction, Dr. Ma's practice includes a range of procedures such as cosmetic breast surgery, hand surgery, and reconstructive facial plastic surgery.

"We're proud to adopt this team approach to plastic surgery that I believe will truly change how patients will address cosmetic and reconstructive needs," Dr. Shenker says. "Our thriving practice will continue to expand to meet the needs of our patients."
