


Dr. Lee Tessler To Be Honored By Voices Against Brain Cancer At October 19 Run/Walk

Dr. Tessler is a resident of Port Washington, NY.


In addition to being honored, Dr. Tessler has donated critically needed funds to support Voices' mission, and

metastatic tumors and meningiomas, using stereotactic surgery and <u>radiosurgery</u>. Dr. Tessler received his undergraduate degree cum laude from Duke University. He obtained his medical degree from The Ohio State University College of Medicine and Public Health. Dr. Tessler served both his internship and residency in the Department of Neurological Surgery at NYU Langone Medical Center, where he was named chief resident. In 2008, Dr. Tessler was appointed as Assistant Professor of Neurosurgery at NYU Langone Medical Center. He is currently Chief of Neurotrauma and Chairman of the Neurosurgery Quality Improvement Committee at Winthrop-University Hospital.

Dr. Tessler serves on Voices Against Brain Cancer's Medical Advisory Board, and was recently named to the Medical Advisory Board of VirtualTrials.org. Among other honors, he is a recipient of the Community Service Award from the Aleh Foundation, which funds Israel's largest provider of educational rehabilitative services to severely developmentally disabled children.
