Love Me Blind is adventurous and accessible, with a lyrical intelligence that is rare in today's rock. Like the band itself, the album is an eclectic venture that somehow seamlessly intertwines rock, hiphop, and pop in a novel and genuinely fresh style.

Rocking audiences from NYC to Seattle, Thick as Thieves has toured extensively across the nation's college markets, opening for Imagine Dragons, Nas, Bassnectar, Empire of the Sun, Sean Kingston, Matt & Kim, Young the Giant, 21 Pilots and Wale, among others. They've played at many of the world famous Hollywood venues (House of Blues, Troubadour, Whisky a Go Go, The Roxy), all the while blazing a path as a collective of the most naturally gifted musicians in the city of Angels. Thick As Thieves dominates the live setting in a way auto-tuned acts can only dream of.
