This version will be free of ads and will allow users to access hints and suggestions. Both versions have access to the single player mode and the multiplayer mode. The single player mode is instantly recognizable as

the world famous version of Sudoku. Perfect for casual and relaxing play, single player is enhanced with a diverse number of puzzles and controllable levels of difficulty. Performance measures are captured and released by the Sudoku Analytics system which tracks and compares individual performance. These measures include average times, average errors per game and total number of games played. This offers gamers a chance to beat their own previous best efforts. The multiplayer mode is where Sudoku Wars takes the game to unprecedented heights. Users can now challenge their friends to the same Sudoku puzzle in real time through social platforms linked to the game. The winner is determined by whoever can complete the Sudoku first.
