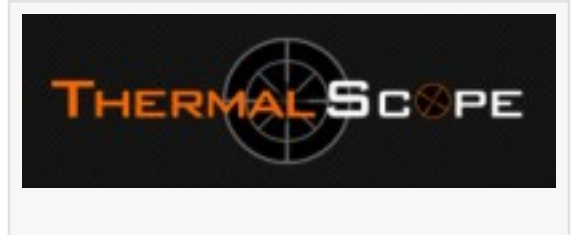


ThermalScope Launches New Thermal Optics Website
