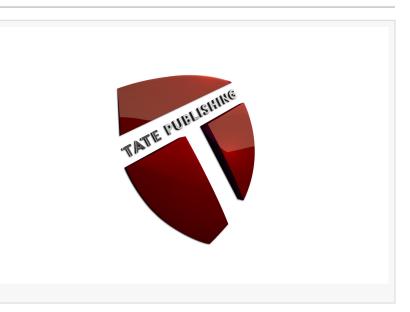


Farmington Hills author signed to publish new Christian book.
