If you can remove even one of these core dynamics, your life will improve. Cora helps her clients identify these core dynamics and eliminate the barriers and self-sabotage that keeps people stuck.

"That's what coaching is all about: helping people find their own answers," says Cora. "It's a co-creative process. It's like we're sleuthing. I help my clients create a clearer picture of

where they want to go. Once we can feel that clear picture, it's amazing how quickly our road blocks to

Cora says she works primarily with influential people, or what she calls "lynchpins." Whether it's a manager or an executive director, if you can help those individuals operate at their best, everyone around them benefits and we can affect more change.

"I'm most proud of helping people go from the impossible to the possible," says Cora. "I'm always amazed by how incredibly open people are. It doesn't happen in a day, but we work on it together. It's very fulfilling to see the changes that can occur in people and then the people around them."
