Raising \$30,000 in order to develop a full mobile simulator. It'll take a lot of resources, including new computer hardware, software, and development resources. Real World Flight Simulator promises that the majority of the planes will provide certification from their manufacturers to confirm that authentic exterior and interior models have been provided for the wide variety of aircraft, including Airbus, Boeing, DeHaviland, Bombardier, and more—a first for the mobile landscape. In addition, accurate flight dynamics will be part of the experience. The Real World Flight Simulator website is in the finishing stages and once it's up and running (estimated launch date is in a week), gaming fans and crowdfunding supporters will be able to learn more about this exciting new venture. Simulator will be released publicly in mid- to late 2015, with the private alpha available on January 31, 2015.

The Real World Flight Simulator will cost \$1.99 when it's ready for the market, unless it's included in your perk package. Add-ons will cost from \$.99 to \$4.99.

By donating to the campaign, your money brings you on board a commercial venture that promises to be a lot of fun for anyone who wants the best in flight simulation gaming. By starting off with a \$2 donation, you become a part of simulation history. You will receive a copy of the game on both iOS and Android on release as a reward for your \$20 gift of support. The \$50 level will also include all aircraft and scenery packages. The \$500 Golden Ticket donation provides donors with one-on-one time with the Real World Flight Simulator developers and a behind-the-scenes glimpse into the development process.
