"I actually started my first autobiography in 2001 but then shelved [it] as I didn't want to recall some painful memories. This one was birthed on June 1st, 2014, [it] took less than 3 months to complete and was entirely handwritten from start to finish. It took me less than 2 hours to write the first 6 parts by hand. I laugh as I recalled my friend's daughter, Mycah, who was sitting next to me, looking at my finger moving rapidly across the page of the notebook I was using to write in and exclaiming, 'Wow, Aunt Marcia, you write fast!' Little did she know that I was only writing that quickly because the story was pouring out of me like a river," recalls Shury.

"*Silent Hearer* is about a girl who loses her hearing in high school after having the mumps twice. Marcia's story takes us on this inspiring journey to be strong enough to battle through success!" shares Shannon Lloyd, the Acquisitions Editor for Tate Publishing.
