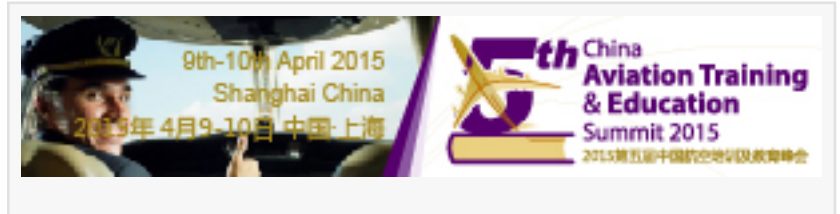


The 5th China Aviation Training & Education (CATES) Summit 2015
