Frost fans draw down the warmer inversion layer air above the plantation and blow it through the orchard. The frost fan blows as much air as it can to the greatest distance.. The distance the artificially generated wind can penetrate into the orchard is the key to the temperature changing technique

The Frost Boss in addition to orchards is also configured to protect ground crops. The company offers its fans under a buy or lease agreement. This integrated financial service has been crucial to the success of the company. This is because of the inherent problem in fruit growing of the long seasonal waits between payouts.
