The Board will be composed of two directors elected from each Interest Category by the members of that category, plus two directors elected "at large" from the general membership. Nominations may come from any SGIP member (including self-nomination) for candidates from within and for that members assigned Interest Category and from the overall membership for the "at large" seats.

Of the nominating process, Sharon Allan states that SGIP, "is striving for a board composed of directors that are industry leaders that can provide strategic oversight to further the mission of the organization."

Nominations for candidates must be no later than 11:59p.m. EST on January 30, 2015. Submissions may be sent by email to the Candidate Evaluation Committee at cec@lists.sgip.org. For consideration, the candidate must be an employee or representative of a SGIP participating member organization.
