


Mary Jane Strain Games, Cards Enhanced

Mary Jane Strain Games is a brand new design of playing cards which is based on marijuana strains and weights instead of the traditional aces, kings, queens, jacks and numbers. The cards have a number of suits which are represented by strains including King Kush, Chocolate



Chip Cookies, Black Kush, Cherry AK-47 Kush, White Widow, Blueberry Yum Yum and Lemon Kush. Instead of numbers the cards use weight measurements like grams and pounds which makes the

scoring methods slightly different than a normal card game. The game variations can be used in so many ways that they are virtually endless. Hustleaire has come up with ten of their own different twists on traditional card games. Each deck comes with playing instructions for all ten of these games. For example spades is now called strain. Strain has 54 cards in the deck and uses seven strains with each strain numbered in the order of their importance. King Kush is the spade suit.

Other card games include Blunts R Trump, Fat Sack – which is a version of blackjack and Pushin' Weight. It is expected that players will create even more games by incorporating the different strain designs themselves. It will be exciting to see what players come up with. It is true that Mary Jane Strain Games came about partially due to the increase in the number of states which have accepted the legalization of marijuana. Ultimately Mary Jane Strain Games is a unique way for people to enjoy their favorite strains or to see what may potentially be their favorite strains. This makes Mary Jane Strain Games a great idea for pot smoking parties.

Hustleaire is a professional company which specializes in urban clothing, magazines, DVDs, books and custom merchandise. But Hustleaire is more than just a magazine.
