As well, there will be various concessions and crafts at the festival located in the Jazz Village. NO HIGH BACK CHAIRS ALLOWED INTO THE FESTIVAL. A high back chair is any chair over 31 inches.

TICKETING INFORMATION: This year's Jazz Festival will again offer free admission to each event for children 12 years of age and under, and a reduced ticket price to each event for children 13-17 years of age for \$25, which will be available at the on-site festival box office on the day of the event only. The Jazz Festival VIP/ Early Bird tickets receive 1st entry from 10am to 12 noon on Saturday and Sunday 11.00 am to 1.00 pm for center of the venue seating with its own cash bar and upgraded executive restroom facilities. Tickets are \$167 in advance including any ticket outlet service charges. General Admission adult tickets in advance are \$111.50 including any ticket outlet service charges.
