


## Brian O'Shea Presents at Upcoming M.I.S.A meeting on Social Hacking and Engineering

in Ottawa, Canada and also will be speaking at the Information Security Conference Southwest in Austin on the 12th of April.

"Cyber Security is an extremely important subject for companies to invest money in for their own information security and protection. However, social hacking and engineering, sometimes called 'human hacking' or manipulation, can sometime yield even more intelligence for nefarious purposes if awareness is not underlined for all

employees."

O'Shea has performed dozens of social hacking penetration tests for hedge funds, large corporations, and even other security firms. Using publicly available knowledge, social media, and manipulation, O'Shea and his team have penetrated many companies networks with a cell phone or a conference call, even after the cyber-infrastructure had been reinforced.

"People like to talk," say O'Shea. "And if they are feeling under appreciated at work, getting ready to leave the job, or simply have too much on their social media page, you can pretty easily get them to tell you even the most intimate company secrets. Companies often time do not even realize they have been hacked, and by then its too late."

O'Shea's presentations help investigators, company leaders, and employees learn what a social attack looks like, how it is executed, and what typically social hackers go after. By the end of each seminar Brian O'Shea's audience and students have an increased awareness of the threat and how to stop it.
