

Plastic Surgeon in Scottsdale Again Named 'Top Doc' in Phoenix Magazine

Besides breast augmentation, Dr. Cohen performs various plastic surgery procedures, including breast lift and <u>tummy tuck surgery</u> at his Scottsdale practice. His patients often refer friends or family members to him, he says, and being included in the magazine's Top Doc issue helps him reach even more community residents considering plastic surgery.

The Scottsdale physician's dedication to the <u>plastic surgery field</u> also extends into research. His ongoing interest in improving outcomes for patients is reflected in the number of research papers he's presented in the past year alone. Additionally, he was asked to serve as an instructor in 2014 at the national meetings of both the American Society of Plastic Surgeons® and the American Society for Aesthetic Plastic Surgery.
