

Women Golfers Present \$750,000 To Cancer Charities

BIGHORN BAM has gifted \$5.25 million over the past 8 years.

Eisenhower Lucy Curci Cancer Center in Rancho Mirage received \$600,000 to support various enhanced technologies including a 3D Breast CT Scanner, four GE Logic s9 Ultrasound machines, Breast MRI Analysis Software and a Breast MRI Coil Invivo 16; while \$150,000 was gifted to The Pendleton Foundation — a non-profit organization helping patients with basic living expenses when they cannot work. Funds also support transportation services to Eisenhower patients undergoing radiation and chemotherapy who would normally rely on public transportation, inspiring over 7,500 round-trip rides and who can now get better faster!

This year marks BIGHORN BAM's eighth year as one of the largest single private fundraisers benefiting [Eisenhower Medical Center](#), a top 100 hospital in America.
