

Warning! Herpes Infection May Result in Mental Problems; CBCD Reviews the Medical Evidence

Some studies show that individuals who have recovered from viral encephalitis (a virus caused inflammation of the brain) may develop mental problems. The meta-analysis showed that oral antiviral therapy decreases the duration and the associated pain of an outbreak by merely one day." (4)
