"I enjoyed a wonderful emotional connection to my body as a dancer, but in my intimate relationships with men I was not able to have that connection," recalls Angela. "On the dance floor I felt empowered. Why couldn't I be that way in my relationships? I was very insecure but I soon discovered many women have had a similar experience. I wasn't the only woman having difficulty understanding how to truly connect in a relationship and make it something joyful."

Angela transitioned her practice from working with the body to working with the whole person – their thoughts, their feelings, and who they were in relationships – to transform them. Transformed Relationships explores our formative experiences in relationships while offering strategies to shift our mindset.

"You can't step into a new relationship and be totally free until you've actually sorted through the past," says Angela. "Unless the emotion systems in the body are rewired or reprogrammed, people tend to revert back to the behavior of fear. With my system when you come into the new relationship with a



person, all those old feelings can come up but you'll recognize them and get back to relating to the person in front of you. This is about coming from a higher place.”

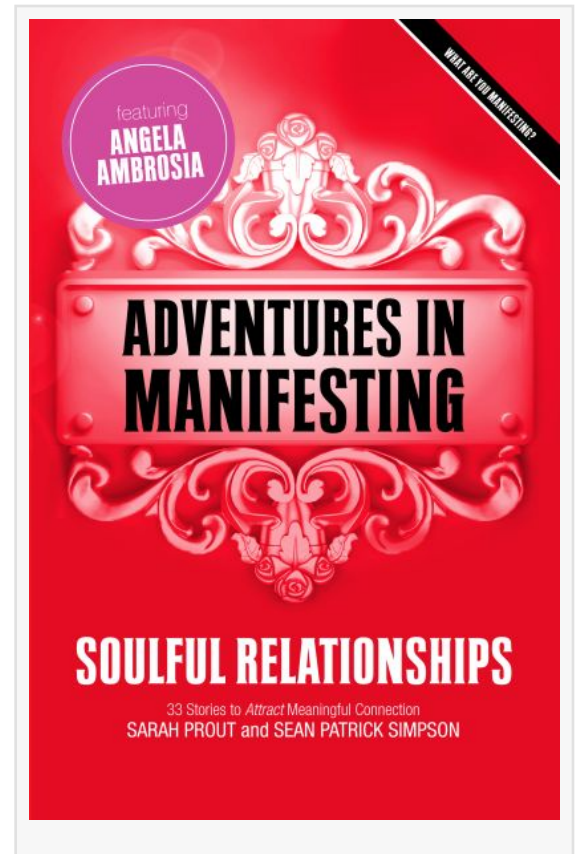
