26th May 2015 between <u>Chicago Blackhawks</u> and Anaheim Ducks displayed a lack of talent among the players. The New York Rangers were shut out with 2-0 in Game 5 of the Eastern Conference final during the playoffs. Game six is on Tuesday night (26th May 2015) at Amalie Arena. A Lightning victory will send Tampa Bay to the Cup finals for the second time in franchise history. And the Rangers are looking to extend the series to a seventh game, which would be played Friday night in New York. After failing to find the back of the net in Tampa

Bay's first eight games this postseason, Stamkos has scored in seven of the past 10 to help the Lightning eliminate Montreal in the second round and take a 3-2 series lead over the Rangers. New York overcame a 3-1 deficit to eliminate the Washington Capitals in the second round. They've been a resilient team in reaching the conference finals three of the past four years, and say they believe they're capable of taking the series back to Madison Square Garden.

Henrik Lundqvist rebounded from allowing 12 combined goals in Games 2 and 3 to shut down the Lightning in Game 4. He didn't play poorly in Game 5, and his reputation for excellence in crucial situation is well known.

The Rangers are 3-0 in elimination games this postseason.

There have been a number of predictions also made by odds-makers as to which team should win or which team will win the Cup this year and its still too early to know.
