

HPV Causes Genital Warts and Cancer in Men; CBCD Reviews the Medical Evidence

Most genital warts develop following infection with HPV 6, 11, or 16. (1)


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

In addition, they wrote that sperm in HPV and Ct (Chlamydia trachomatis) infected men did not move or "swim" like healthy sperm. The Center for the Biology of Chronic Disease (CBCD) recommends that men infected with HPV take Gene-Eden-VIR or Novirin. These procedures use liquid nitrogen, a surgical knife (scalpel), a carbon dioxide (CO2) laser, or electrical current to remove the abnormal growths caused by the HPV. These growths include cells that harbor the active virus. The procedures do not target cells with the latent virus. Since they do not remove the latent virus, these procedures only produce a temporary remission." (4) In contrast, Novirin and Gene-Eden-VIR were designed to target the latent HPV.
