High risk work groups for exposure to asbestos in South Carolina include Veterans of the US Navy, power plant workers, shipyard workers, factory workers, plumbers, electricians, auto mechanics, machinists, and construction workers. Typically the exposure to asbestos occurred in the 1950's, 1960's, 1970's, or 1980's.
